SMOKE & MIRRORS is her debut novel.







This story encourages readers to stand up for the truth, even when others can't see it, and reminds us all that sometimes it's the kids in our lives who see things most clearly.


STRONG SOCIAL THEMES


Ransaw tackles delicate social topics such as bullying, prejudice, and the injustices of our justice system with a refreshing mix of realism and compassion.
